ACADEMICS

At Regenesys, we do not restrict learning to the classroom. Our teaching focuses on practical knowledge as much as the theories. We ensure that our students apply their knowledge to the real- world situations and learn from the outcomes.

The Regenians were introduced to this concept of practical learning in the second week with us. They were asked to become entrepreneurs for a day. The students were divided in four teams and each team was given a seed fund of Rs 500 from the college. The teams were asked to think of creative profitable business ideas, go out in the real world and multiply the investment.

As expected, the Regenians did not disappoint us.

The teams came up with very innovative business ideas and each of them returned with profit. **Team 1** took to selling fast food in the college and made a profit of Rs.210, **Team 2** gave head massage to people in and around the college, recording a profit of Rs.400, and Team 4 sold saplings on the streets of Vashi, earning a profit of Rs 500. **Team 3** was the undisputed winner, making a profit of Rs 1,820. They earned the money by entertaining people on the streets through their dance and song performances.

On the eve of the India's 70th Independence Day, our students went out on the streets of Vashi to interact with fellow Indians and understand what independence actually means to them.
